**L. Lorong Dockyard**

At the end of Lebuah Jaya is a small alley called Lorong Dockyard, which used to be roofed. Here, traders sold all sorts of cheap and easy to carry items on its five-foot way. Now, it is just an empty alley connecting Jalan Market to the famous Brooke Dockyard.
