Diana Rose will be sharing with us her experience championing for the preservation of Melanau intangible cultural heritage and Dr. Rolf Schlömer will share with us his journey and findings in tracing the materials and records about this endangered Melanau cultural healing practice and in particular, his views on the Melanau good luck charms, the Suk.
