

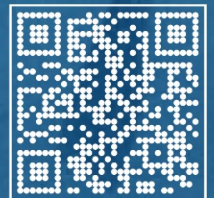

DR. AZMI HASSAN

Dr. Azmi Hassan is currently a GeoStrategist and Senior Fellow at Nusantara Academy for Strategic Research NASR. He has conducted numerous research and consultant works and his recent works include The Angkasawan Malaysia Program that evaluates the benefit of sending the first Angkasawan to the International Space Station (ISS). He writes for the mainstream media of The New Straits Times, Berita Harian and more recently Utusan Malaysia opined about defense, strategic and geopolitics. Azmi is the owner of patent 6052082 issued by the United States Department of Commerce, Patent and Trademark Office that deals with algorithms that can be employed to mitigate the U.S. Pentagon's GPS Anti-Spoofing policy. The patent is part of Azmi's Ph.D. dissertation from University of Wisconsin-Madison, USA.
